

Signatory Companies

The voluntary PhRMA Code on Interactions with Healthcare Professionals (PhRMA Code) states that all companies that interact with healthcare professionals about pharmaceuticals should adopt procedures that foster compliance with the PhRMA Code. It also states that PhRMA will identify on its website all companies that announce their commitment to abide by the Code and complete (at the appropriate time) an annual certification that they have policies and procedures in place to foster compliance with the Code.
